



DISASTER DECLARATION

May 28, 2019

Whereas, the Town of Pendleton, Indiana has been impacted by or is immediately threatened by the following emergency conditions:

On May 27, 2019 at approximately 20:00, severe weather, including a possible tornado, impacted the Town of Pendleton, Indiana. The impacts are being calculated, assessed and addressed and may exist for at least the next seven days following the storm.

Now, therefore, I, as the President of the Pendleton Town Council, with the authority invested in my office by Indiana Code § 10-14-3-29(a)(1), declare the local disaster emergency exists for seven days in the Town of Pendleton and hereby invoke those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this Declaration to be in full force and effect in the Town of Pendleton for the exercise of all necessary emergency measures necessary for the protection of lives and property and the prompt restoration of local government services.

The effect of this Declaration is to:

(1) Activate the response and recovery aspects of all applicable county disaster emergency plans.

(2) Authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under the plans.

(3) Declare a travel warning, during which travel shall be restricted to emergency personnel only. This travel warning shall only be in effect in the Town of Pendleton in those areas designated by appropriate personnel. If emergency personnel determine that travel no longer needs to be restricted, emergency personnel may allow travel without violating this declaration. During a travel warning, all citizens are called upon and directed to refrain from all travel, to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans and to obey and comply with lawful directions of properly identified officers.

All public officers and employees of the Town of Pendleton are directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in



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execution of emergency laws, regulations and directives state and local.


In accordance with Indiana Code § 10-14-3-29(d), this Declaration does not prohibit individuals engaged in employment necessary to maintain a safe rail system, restore a public utility or provide any other emergency public service from traveling within the area of the Town of Pendleton identified in the travel warning during this local disaster emergency.

All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Madison County emergency Operations Center, if activated, if not, then County 911 Center.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions and particularly the Indiana Code § 10-14-3-29.

This Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly in the office of the Town Clerk.

This Declaration takes effect on May 28, 2019 and terminates on June 2, 2019 at 19:59 local time.

Whereas, County of Madison, Indiana has been impacted by or is immediately threatened by a natural gas leak. Our main focus will be to evacuate and secure areas to protect the citizens and property of Madison County.

Now, therefore, we, the Board of County Commissioners, declare that a local emergency exists in the County of Madison and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the county for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of the county of Madison and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, and resolutions, and particularly to section 10-4-1-23 of the Indiana Code.

All public offices and employees of the County of Madison are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of this emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives-state and local. Citizens are asked to remain at home during this emergency, but will not restrict travel by the general public if it is an emergency.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to be cooperative with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.

All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Madison County Emergency Operations Center if activated, if not, then the County 911 Center.
