

The Pendleton Town Council met in regular session at 6:00PM on Friday, March 8, 2019 at its regular place of business located at 100 West State Street Pendleton, Madison County, Indiana.

All documents presented during the meeting are on file in the Pendleton Clerk Treasurer's Office and may be reviewed upon request.

Town Council President Smith called the meeting of the Town Council to order at 6:00PM. She called for a moment of silence and then asked Chris Davis to lead the pledge of allegiance.

Roll call was taken and quorum established.

Council members present: Jessica Smith, Chad Wolfe, Jessica Bastin, Robert Jones, Chet Babb.

Also present: Clerk Treasurer Matt Roberts, Town Manager Tim McClintick, Town Attorney Alex Intermill.

R. Jones moved to approve the agenda and J. Bastin seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

The Council certified by a vote of 5-0 that nothing was discussed in the executive session held immediately prior to the public meeting other than the issues provided in the notice and as allowed by law.

President Smith provided a brief statement regarding the Council's desire to resolve the disciplinary matter with M. Farrer according to the terms agreed upon in the settlement negotiations.

Attorney Intermill read the terms of the proposed settlement which were:


- a) Mr. Farrer shall remain on the Pendleton Police Department at the rank of patrolman and shall receive patrolman's pay commensurate with his number of years of experience as a police officer;
- b) Mr. Farrer will have four calendar weeks unpaid leave beginning on the Effective Date during which time Mr. Farrer may utilize any vacation, PTO, or other leave he has accrued;
- c) Mr. Farrer shall be on probation for 12 months from the Effective Date during which time he shall have no supervisory, management, or training roles in the Department, excluding the necessity of his directing a reserve officer while on duty; and
- d) Mr. Farrer shall successfully complete sensitivity and diversity training.

J. Bastin moved to approve the settlement agreement pursuant to the terms read by Attorney Intermill. C. Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.


Ofc. Farrer read a prepared apology and the Council thanked him for his apology.
