

# Grovelawn Cemetery

## **REMOVABLE GRAVE DECORATION GUIDELINES**

The intent of these guidelines is to provide safe, organized and aesthetically pleasing environment in the cemetery.

### **ANY REMOVABLE WINTER DECORATIONS** (November 1 to March 1)

- Decorations including “grave blankets” and holiday decorations may be placed on the ground in front of a grave beginning November 1<sup>st</sup> and must be removed by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **HOLIDAY DISPLAYS** (March 1 to November 1)

- Decorations may be placed on the ground in front of a grave beginning the first full weekend prior to Mothers Day, Memorial Day, Fathers Day, and July 4<sup>th</sup>. The decorations must be removed by the end of the first full weekend following the specific holiday.

### **DECORATIONS AT ALL OTHER TIMES** (year around)

- All ornaments, flowers, “shepherd’s hooks” and similar devices **MUST** be on the marker or concrete foundation
- Temporary and removable markers will be acceptable for a period of six months after the burial date
- “Shepherd’s hooks” and similar devices shall extend no higher than 36” above the top of the marker
- No hanging devices including flower pots may be larger than a common 10 inch flower pot
- No decorations or hanging devices may extend past the edge of the concrete foundation
- No live plants may be planted in the ground at any time
- No glass on or around any grave at any time

All items not in compliance with these guidelines or found in a damaged, dilapidated condition will be removed and discarded by Cemetery personnel without notice.
