

Pendleton Town Council
June 10, 2021

The Pendleton Town Council met in regular session at 6:00pm on June 10, 2021 at the Pendleton Town Hall, 100 West State Street, Pendleton, Indiana. All documents presented are on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office and may be reviewed upon request. Town Council President, Chet Babb, called the meeting of the Pendleton Town Council to order.

Council Members present were President Chet Babb, Vice President Shane Davis, Robert Jones, Steve Denny and Marissa Skaggs. A quorum was established with five of five members present. Clerk-Treasurer Willie Boles was present.

Also representing the Town were Town Manager Scott Reske, Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Karen Parkison, Police Marshall Marc Farrer, Judge George Gasparovic, Assistant Fire Chief Jim Stewart, and Denise McKee.

The minutes from the May meeting were approved without any corrections. Robert Jones made a motion to approve and Shane Davis seconded. Motion carried with a roll call vote of five to zero.

CLERK-TREASURER'S REPORT

Clerk-Treasurer Willie Boles presented the claims and the financial report for May 2021.

A motion to approve the claims and financial report as presented was made by Steve Denny and 2nd by Robert Jones. Motion carried with a roll call vote of five to zero.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Fire Department – Jim Stewart presented his report. He stated that the drone was in and operating. 3 people are licensed and it has been used twice so far.

Police Department – Town Marshall Marc Farrer presented his report. He also reported that Captain Randy Sidwell is retiring on July 9th after serving for 25 years.

Town Court – Judge Gasparovic presented his report.

Planning and Town Manager – Scott Reske presented his report.

NEW BUSINESS

Ordinance 21-14 – Updating labor and surcharges.

- This ordinance will update a previous ordinance with a change in one labor rate and an additional surcharge for subcontracting work.

Motion to approve Ordinance 21-14 on the second reading was made by Robert Jones and 2nd by Shane Davis. Motion carried with a roll call vote of five to zero.

Reconstruction Award-Franklin Street

- 1.47 million dollar reconstruction bid for Franklin Street. Two bids (Calumet Civil Engineering and United Construction) were submitted with a recommendation from Banning Engineering to accept the bid from Calumet Civil Contractors.

Motion to agree to the bid submitted by Calumet Civil Engineering was made by Robert Jones and 2nd by Shane Davis. Motion carried with a roll call vote of five to zero.

US 36 Project CDM Smith – Pedestrian Connectivity

- CDM Smith contract will provide professional services on the reconstruction of pedestrian trails and other design and plan developments for US 36 when INDOT plans to start reconstruction in 2023. Discussions followed on funding, delay in the start date and a tunnel/bridge to the school.

Motion to approve contract was made by Steve Denny and 2nd by Shane Davis. Motion carried with a roll call vote of five to zero.

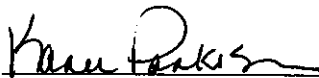

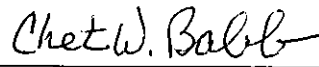
