MS4 Permit Audit

- Denise McKee stated that we successfully passed the MS4 Permit Audit and gave a brief summary of the takeaways:
 - A barrier needed created for the salt barn
 - Exposed transformer casings needed removed & placed in storage
 - Wall signage for drainage in facilities
- All items have been taken care of & we are in good standing

MS4 Storm Water Ordinance

- Denise spoke regarding permits created from IDDE regarding Storm Water and construction permits.
 - Construction 1 acre or more must file permit with IDDE and remain compliant.

- We as a municipality must assure, they are compliant with those regulations.

- To do so we have one Storm Water Management Ordinance that is comprehensive that pulls all provisions of both permits together as one.
 - Ordinance - Majority of regulatory authority and general requirements of Storm Water Management.
 - Standards – A companion document to be approved along with the ordinance. The means and methods of achieving those regulatory requirements.
 - This is a state wide supported & accepted document that has been tailored for the Town of Pendleton.
- Brady Dryer from Common Wealth spoke regarding the changes to the Storm Water Technical Standards Manuel.
 - Kyle Eichhorn asked if we currently have a 1999 Drainage Standards Ordinance. – Yes, we do.
- Zach Berline motioned and Kyle Eichhorn seconded for a favorable recommendation to the Pendleton Town Council concerning the attached amendments to the Storm Water Ordinance No. 2021-05.
