STAFF FINDINGS

Zoning Ordinance

158.10 Sign Regulations

158.10.02 General Requirements and Provisions

A. Maximum sign area is 60 square feet. (This sign is 74 square feet.)

158.10.03 Exempt Signage: The following types of signs are exempted from all the provisions of this chapter except for construction and safety regulations:

1. Signs setting forth the name of any simple announcement for any public, charitable, educational or religious institution located entirely within the premise of that institution, up to an area of 24 square feet. Such signs may be illuminated in accordance with the regulations contained herein. If ground mounted, the top shall be no more than six feet above ground level. (This sign exceeds square footage and height requirements for an exempt institutional sign.)

Staff Recommendations Approve as presented.

Ron Barnhart addressed the board with explanation on size. If it were to be reduced in size it will change the proportions of the sign. One row of block on the bottom would need to be removed. The park's desire is to landscape around the sign and, with the reduced height, it would eliminate the landscaping area. The material incorporated into the sign design is surplus from the construction of the office. Barnhart went on to explain the lighting would be in the ground pointed up at the sign.

Bowman acknowledged that there was no public present in opposition or support.
