Kayla Hassett presented on Google Drive. The presentation included the Variance Application submitted by Chris Vensel representing Klipsch-Card Athletic Facilities LLC, aerial view of the property, structure and property diagrams and renderings of the structure and property.

Hassett explained that the sign will be larger than the ordinance allows which is, in no case, larger than 100 square feet, and this request is for 460 square feet and 28" deep. She went on to state that according to the Planned Business Design Guidelines, all signs should be architecturally integrated with their surroundings in terms of size, shape, color, texture, and lighting so that they are complementary to the overall design of the buildings.

Staff Recommendation – Option 1

Table this petition until Planning receives a more detailed sign plan.

Staff Recommendation – Option 2

Approve a variance for a sign up to 450 square feet and 28 inches deep, and located as shown in the elevation drawings.

Vensel advised that the sign will be visible as soon as you turn East from the interstate.

Bowman asked if Option 2 could be construed as allowing, for example, a changeable sign or an LED or a glittering moving sign. Hassett reported that this sign will be individual letters. Adding that if it were a back lit box sign there might be a chance for refacing.

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Pritchard reported that he is fine with Option 2, in consideration that they are having to move forward with planning and constructing the building. And it does appear that the size of the sign is proportional to the structure. Also, the direction the building faces supports it as well.
