- I. Meeting called to order at 5:00 pm by Park Board President Bryan Williams. Additional board members present: Jennifer Roberts, Brian Slick, Lauretta Gray, Lindsey Madingerand Ana Blake. Also present, Park Director Aaron Burris, Park Attorney Bill Davisson, Park Secretary Bobbi Cline and Marissa Skaggs.
- II. ____Review and Approval of 2023 Budget
 - a. Ana Blake in reference to uniforms: Can we get laundry service? Answer Aaron Burris: We have one, it is no good.
 - b. 2023 Salary Resolution As long as the numbers fit into the approved budget there will be no issues and the board has until December to set the next year's wages.
 - c. Salary positions are Park Director and Maintenance Director.
 - d. Question asked: Why are the raise % so high? Answer: The numbers in the proposed budget are estimates and not necessarily raise requests.
 - e. Insurance for 2023 will stay the same as 2022.
 - f. Question: When will the town 2023 salary resolution be complete? Answer: September 8 is the goal. The town pay resolution will not be mentioned in the town resolution.
 - g. Raise cap will be set at 7.8%. Town has discussed the future of the park pay resolution, raises, etc and will not interfere.
 - h. 2023 Budget approval motion by Ana Blake, 2nd by Jennifer Roberts and approved by all.
- III. Playground Equipment
 - a. All salvageable equipment will be kept and used in other places in the park.
 - b. All other pieces will be auctioned as-is at a public auction within 6-8 weeks.
- IV. Trees Removed from Playground Area
 - a. All wood has been placed by the dog park and is free for anyone to take after they have signed a waiver.
