The Pendleton Town Council met in a special session at 6:00pm on October 27th, 2021 at the Pendleton Town Hall, 100 West State Street, Pendleton, Indiana. All documents presented are on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office and may be reviewed upon request. Town Council President, Chet Babb, called the meeting of the Pendleton Town Council to order.

This is only a pass through cost for the town. The town does not make money off of trash removal. The town will go back to picking up limbs and heavy trash day will be once a month. The increase rates will be from \$12.74 per month to \$14.00. President Babb stated that we were at the bottom of the cost of trash removal compared to other towns.
