### **CALL TO ORDER**

The Pendleton Town Council met in regular session on December 9, 2021 at 6:00 pm at the Pendleton Town Hall. Council President Babb called the meeting to order. All documents presented are on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office and may be reviewed upon request.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Resolution 21-14

This was an additional appropriation for the Fire Department related to their increased costs in compensation due to acquiring the Town of Ingalls fire territory. Motion to approve was made by Robert Jones and seconded by Shane Davis. Roll call vote to approve was 5-0.

Lease Agreement was presented by Chief Nodine on the use of the fire trucks and ambulance from the Town of Ingalls. Jones asked if repairs needed to be made to the equipment, was it our responsibility? Answer from Chief was yes. Motion made to authorize the lease agreement was made by Shane Davis and seconded by Steve Denny. Roll call vote to approve was 5-0.

Ordinance 21-30

This was an ordinance to approve the Official Zoning Map of the Town of Pendleton as recommended by the Plan Commission. Attorney Edward Wolenty publicly voiced his objections to passing this ordinance on behalf of his client.

**Ordinance 21-31**




